Christopher Magadini is a well-known artist in our area. His style could be called Contemporary Impressionism although the pastoral quality of his work recalls the naturalism of 19th Century American Landscape Painting. In all of his oils, Christopher takes full advantage of the medium's wonderful qualities. No matter the size, 4"x 6" up to 30"x 40", his work exhibits a rich painterly surface enhanced by masterful brushwork. Christopher says "For me, painting is not simply the replication of what the eye sees. It is the creation of an image that embodies my thoughts and feelings. These, I think, are fairly universal, and I seek to communicate and connect with viewers on that level."

In recent years, Christopher has become known as a plein air painter. His growing popularity has brought avid collectors to galleries and his work has been exhibited worldwide. Christopher was born in Great Barrington, MA, in 1946, and raised in Palm Springs and Los Angeles, CA and Phoenix AZ. After graduating from The Art Center College of Design in Los Angeles in 1970, Christopher pursued commercial illustration in Stockholm, Sweden. He has taught at Marymount College in Tarrytown, NY, and has been a guest lecturer at the School of Visual Arts in Manhattan. He lives in Croton-on-Hudson, NY, and summers in the Adirondacks.
