This class will introduce a wide range of new techniques and will bring the fun and passion back into watercolor by encouraging you to be loose and daring. Value contrast, dynamic composition, color interplay and stretching the boundaries of watercolor will be covered. Sandra Cointreau is a signature member of the Connecticut Watercolor Society and has exhibited in several juried shows. Her work is on display at the Riverwind Gallery in Beacon, NY and has been shown at Lime Rock Raceway, where she was the resident artist in 2016 and was featured in the Drivers' Lounge in 2016.

Still Life in Oil with Rick Daskam

Working from simple still-life setups, Rick Daskam's goal is to teach students to see objects pictorially - to see light and dark values in color, to mass simple shapes, to produce accurate drawing. A graduate of the Paier College of Art, Rick spent many years illustrating because of the influence of N.C. Wyeth, who had a predominant effect on his career. His works have earned many awards including the Claude Parsons Award for Landscape, the Edmond F. Ward Award and the Frank Vincent Dumond Award from The Hudson Valley Art Association.

Drawing Essentials with Lisa Willvonseder Greto

This class will explore basic concepts such as contour drawing, shading, proportion, perspective and composition.
