Watercolor with Diane Dubreuil

Tuesdays (9:30 AM to Noon): March 21 & 28, April 4, 11, 18 & 25

Mastering the watercolor medium takes time, patience, and practice. In a casual setting, each week a challenge will be presented to enhance and enliven the skills of the beginner or practicing watercolorist. We will explore planning our paintings, talk about materials, experiment with transparent vs. opaque, direct painting, wet-in-wet, and other elements present in good paintings. Students will receive individual attention. The session will end with each student sharing his/her accomplishment of the day. Diane studied watercolor with Frank Webb and his influence helped formulate her preference for the medium. She works as a commercial artist and teaches drawing and painting classes at local schools and regional arts organizations.

Still Life in Oil with Rick Daskam

Wednesdays (1:00 to 3:30PM): March 29, April 5, 12 & 19, May 3 & 10 (No class on April 26)

(AM session pre-filled by earlier participants: 9:30 to Noon)

Working from simple still-life setups, Rick Daskam's goal is to teach students to see objects pictorially - to see light and dark values in color, to mass simple shapes, to produce accurate drawing. A graduate of the Paier College of Art, Rick spent many years illustrating because of the influence of N.C. Wyeth, who had a predominant effect on his career. His works have earned many awards including the Claude Parsons Award for Landscape, the Edmond F. Ward Award and the Frank Vincent Dumond Award from The Hudson Valley Art Association.

Drawing Essentials with Lisa Willvonseder Greto

Thursdays (9:30 AM to Noon): March 16 & 30, April 6, 13, 20 & 27 (No class on March 23)

This class will explore basic concepts such as contour drawing, shading, proportion, perspective and composition. Lisa Willvonseder-Greto is an award winning artist and has been a practicing artist for over 30 years. She attended Syracuse University and graduated Magna Cum Laude with a B.F.A. from S.U.N.Y. Purchase. Lisa teaches privately and she is now offering a 6 week introductory class in Drawing through SCAN.
